# Statement of Principle

Please read, initial, and sign the following:

- I recognize Options on 8 is a Christian Ministry. Therefore, Options on 8, embodied in its volunteers, is committed to presenting the gospel of Christ to women with unexpected or unwanted pregnancies, both in word and in deed. Commensurate with this purpose, those who serve as Options on 8 board of directors, directors, staff and volunteers are expected to know Christ as their Savior and Lord.
- Options on 8 is committed to providing its clients with medically accurate and complete information about both prenatal development and abortion.
- Options on 8 is committed to integrity in dealing with clients, earning their trust and providing promised information and services.
- Options on 8 is committed to assisting women to carry to term, and beyond, by providing emotional and spiritual support and practical assistance. Through the provision of God's people and the community at large, women may face the future with hope, and plan constructively for themselves and their babies.
- Options on 8 does not discriminate in providing services because of race, creed, color, national origin, age or marital status of its clients.
- Options on 8 does not recommend, provide, or refer for abortion or abortifacients.
- Options on 8 is committed to creating an awareness within our communities of the needs of pregnant women, and of the fact that abortion only compounds human need rather than resolving it.
- Options on 8 does not recommend, provide, or refer single women for contraceptives. Married women seeking contraception information should be urged to seek council, along with their husbands, from their pastor and/or physician.
- Options on 8 recognizes the validity of adoption as one alternative to abortion but is not biased toward adoption when compared to the other life-saving alternatives. Options on 8 is independent of adoption agencies, relating to them in the same manner as to other helpful referral sources.

Options on 8 receives no payment of any kind from these agencies nor does it enter into any contractual relationships with them. Options on 8 neither initiates nor facilitates independent adoptions.

#### MISSION STATEMENT:

Options on 8 is a life-affirming pregnancy care center. We help families thrive during and after unexpected pregnancies with emotional, spiritual, educational, material support and limited medical services.

### Statement of Faith

- We believe in one God (Deut. 5:7,6:4). We believe He has revealed himself through the Trinity; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit (Mt.3:16, 17; Jn. 14:26) and He has spoken to us through the scriptures, the inspired and infallible word of God. (2Tim. 3:16)
- We believe that Jesus is the Son of God and that he was fully human and fully God, that He is the express image of the invisible God. (Jn 3:16; Col. 1:15)
- o We believe that Jesus was sinless, though tempted, He never yielded to temptation. (Heb. 4:15)
- o We believe that Jesus is the Lamb of God offered up as a sacrifice. "To take away the sin of the world." (Jn. 1:29)
- We believe that he overcame death and rose from the tomb on the third day and won the victory over hell, death and the grave. No one can be saved by any other name than the name of Jesus. (Matt. 28:1-7; Rev 1:18, Acts 4:12; Phil. 2:9-11)
- We believe that salvation is a free gift of God-a precious gift paid for by the blood of His Son (Jn. 3:16). Works are a result of salvation, not a means to salvation. (Eph. 2:8-9)
- We believe that every believer needs to be empowered by the Holy Spirit. We believe in the gifts of the Spirit and the greatest evidence of all the gifts of the Spirit is love. (Eph. 5:18; 1cor. 13:12-13).
- We believe that though Jesus came to save us from hell and eternal death he also saved us to be salt and light (Matt. 5:13-14); to be our brother's keeper (Lk.10:30-37); to be the image of God's love to a dying world. (1Jn. 4:7-8).
- We believe that Jesus Christ will physically return to earth. "Coming in the clouds of glory." (Matt. 24:27-30; 1Thes. 3:13). This time he will come to judge the world and avenge the honor of his Father, and he blood of all who died for the testimony of God. (Rev. 6:9,10; 19:11-16)
- We believe God has called us to be a voice for the voiceless, to stand in the gap for those oppressed by immoral law. Especially the unborn. (Prov. 24:11-12). We believe that God has called us to a fast of righteousness (Is 58).
- We believe that God has called us to stand firm on behalf of justice, not to bow to immoral law, but to uphold the law of our God (Dan. Chapters 3&6).
- We believe that the unborn is a living human being from the moment of conception (Ps. 139:13-16;Is 49:15-16); a unique person known by God (Jer. 1:5).
- We believe in God's commandment that says "Thou shall not kill" We believe that abortion is the taking of an innocent life and is not an alternative to unwanted pregnancy. (Deut. 5:7).
- We believe all life is of great quality to God (Ex. 4:10-12), and that God assigns a time to be born and a time to die (Ecc. 3:1-2).
- We believe that faith without works is dead. We believe there is a time to put shoes on our prayers and do the work of Christ (James 2:14-18; Jn 3:3-18).
- We believe that it is necessary for a person to make a personal commitment to Jesus Christ as Lord and Savior (Jn. 1:12-13; Jn.3:3-18).
